**Learning for ALL** is a partnership project which aims to improve adult literacy and numeracy in the Scottish Borders.

### We provide:

- Literacy and numeracy tuition and guidance
- Awareness raising of the impact of literacies on people's lives

We also support and work with a learners' forum.

We work with people over 16 who have limited initial education and are:

- Unemployed/facing redundancy
- In low skilled jobs on low incomes
- Speakers of other languages
- Living in disadvantaged areas
- Dealing with disability
